The Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology is searching for a 9-month tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant Professor. The Department offers an undergraduate pre-professional degree in speech-language pathology and audiology, an M.S. degree in speech-language pathology, and the Doctorate of Audiology (Au.D.). The graduate programs in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology hold CAA accreditation. There are approximately 200 undergraduate and 75 graduate students at present. Applicants for this position must have a doctorate in Speech-Language Pathology, be eligible for licensure in the state of West Virginia, and hold the Certificate of Clinical Competence (CCC-SLP). ABD candidates will be considered but preference will be given to applicants with the doctorate. Expertise in cognitive-communication or child language/literacy disorders is preferred. Responsibilities include teaching graduate and undergraduate classes, clinical supervision, service consisting of student advising and committee work, research involving the presentation of original research at professional meetings and publishing in peer-reviewed journals. Salary is based on qualifications and experience; summer employment is possible. Located in Morgantown in the beautiful mountains of north-central West Virginia along the Monongahela River, WVU is within driving distance to Pittsburgh to the north and to Washington, D.C., to the east. WVU's Dual Career Program is designed to assist the spouse or partner of a newly recruited faculty member who seeks employment in Morgantown and the surrounding area. The position will remain open until filled, but priority will be given to those whose applications are received by December 4, 2009.
